

2017-18 HEALTH SYSTEM FLU POLICIES

Beaumont Health

We are unable to take any student that does not have or cannot take the influenza vaccine, even if they have an exception.

Beaumont Oakwood Legacy

Flu vaccine is required, can be nasal or injection. We do not accept declinations or waivers. Full policy can be found on orientation website.

Detroit Medical Center

Individuals with a medical contraindication must present a letter from their personal physician/vaccine provider documenting their allergy to the vaccine including specific symptoms. This documentation is to be submitted following the same directions as the flu vaccination documentation. Individuals who cannot receive the flu vaccine must wear a mask when within 6 feet of patients throughout the flu season.

Garden City Hospital

GCH requires the flu vaccine for all employee's and students. However, if the individual is not able to receive the immunization a waiver is to be completed by a physician. The specific waiver form can be supplied upon request.

Henry Ford Health System

Students/Faculty must either have a flu vaccine or an approved waiver. The appropriate form to have a waiver approved can be provided upon request.

Hospice of Michigan

All employees, full-time, part-time and contingent, and volunteers are encouraged to receive an influenza vaccine, no later than November 1, 2016. However, this year HOM is not requiring staff to receive the vaccine, but they are encouraging staff.

Memorial Healthcare - Owosso

Flu vaccine is required for all students. If the student is unable to receive the immunization, they will need to have Memorial's waiver form completed by their physician. The form is then reviewed by the Infection Prevention Committee for approval.

ProMedica Monroe Regional Hospital

Exemption/declination forms will be accepted in lieu of receiving the vaccine. They will be approved on a case by case basis. Masking will be mandatory for anyone not receiving the vaccine.

St. John Health

Flu vaccine is required; SJPHS is accepting waivers if they are approved by the Occupational Health leadership. The process of sending the waivers will be the same as last year's process with any waivers and physician notes going to Tammie Rogers. Per our Occupational Health associates and/or students with waivers will not wear a mask just as in the years past.

Trinity Health

Flu vaccine is required, declination allowed only with MD documentation and if outlined on Trinity's Influenza Declination Form. Exception: **St. Joseph Mercy Oakland**. All students must be vaccinated against the flu, waivers/declinations are not accepted.

University of Michigan Health System:

For the 2015-2016 influenza season, UMHS has amended its influenza immunization policy to mandate vaccination for all UMHS workforce members reinforcing our commitment to patient, employee & visitor safety. (Workforce members are defined to include faculty and students). Two exemptions will be allowed:

Medical: only for prior documented history of neurologic complication after influenza vaccine

Religious: requests will be reviewed by the Medical Ethics Review Committee (MERC)
